## I. The Time of His Birth, Luke 2:1-6

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child.

v.6 And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. (All Scripture in ESV unless otherwise stated)

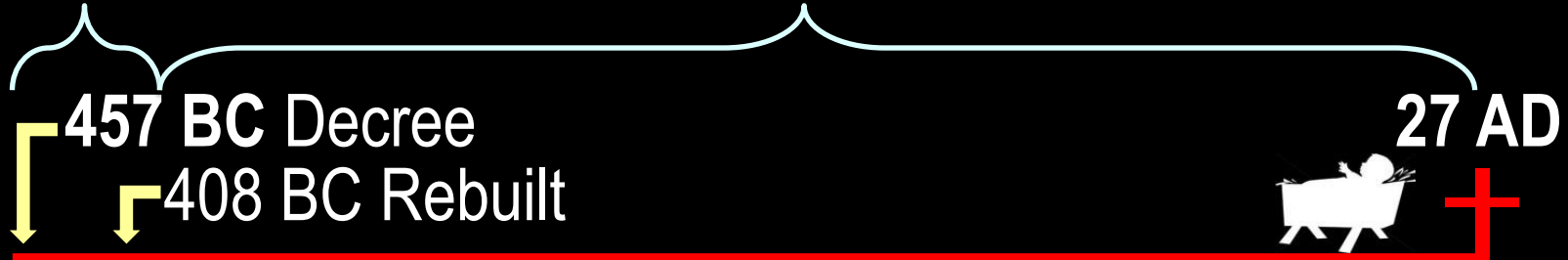
## I. The Time of His Birth, Luke 2:1-6

Daniel 9:24-26a Gabriel's Message "A period of seventy sets of seven has been decreed for your people and your holy city to finish their rebellion, to put an end to their sin, to atone for their guilt, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to confirm the prophetic vision, and to anoint the Most Holy Place. Now listen and understand! Seven sets of seven plus sixty-two sets of seven will pass from the time the command is given to rebuild Jerusalem until a ruler-the Anointed One-comes. Jerusalem will be rebuilt with streets and strong defenses, despite the perilous times. After this period of sixty-two sets of seven, the Anointed One will be killed, appearing to have accomplished nothing." (NLT)

7 “Weeks”

62 “Weeks”



Nehemiah 2:1-8  
Ezra 7:7, 8

483 years

Calculation: 7 years (1 “Week”) X 69 = 483 years

457 BC to 27 AD = 483 (B.C.1 to A.D.1 = 1 year)

Christ was 33 year old when He was crucified

He would be born in 7 BC as Herod died 4 BC

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Luke 1:31, 34, 35 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus... And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?" And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God.

Belief in the Virgin Birth is Essential to Affirm:

A. The Truthfulness of the Bible,

Luke 1:26, 27 In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary.
